Autumn Pumpkin Chili Recipe

This is a different but tasty fall-inspired recipe which is sure to tempt even the most picky of eaters!

Ingredients:

- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 1 small green pepper, chopped
- 1 small sweet yellow pepper, chopped
- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 garlic clove, minced
- 1 pound ground turkey
- 1 can (15 oz) solid-pack pumpkin (not pie filling)
- 1 can (14 oz) diced tomatoes
- 5 tsp chili powder
- 1/4 tsp pepper
- 1/4 tsp salt

Optional topping: shredded cheddar and sour cream



Directions:

- 1. Saute the onion and green and yellow peppers in olive oil in a large skillet until tender.
- 2. Add garlic, cook 1 minute longer. Crumble turkey into skillet. Cook over medium heat until meat is no longer pink. Stir in the pumpkin, tomatoes, chili powder, pepper and salt.
- 3. Transfer mixture to a 4 qt pot. Bring to a boil, stirring regularly. Once boiling, reduce heat and simmer for 30 minutes.
- 4. Serve with sour cream and shredded cheddar cheese as garnish.

Anode Rods Save Water Heaters

The average storage tank water heater lasts 12-15 years. Like all averages, some last shorter and others longer. If there's one single thing you can do to assure that your home's water heater survives to the far end of the scale and beyond, it's to have it regularly serviced, in particular, replacing the anode rod(s) when necessary.

If you're like most homeowners, you probably have never seen your water heater's anode rod and don't even know what it is. Anode rods are made of magnesium or aluminum, or a combination of aluminum, zinc, and tin. These rods are wrapped around a steel core and screwed upside down inside the top of a water tank. Smaller water heaters will have a single anode rod, while bigger models could have two or more. Commercial water heaters may have as many as five.

The main function of anode rods is to prevent corrosion of your water heater tank and internal components. They are often called "sacrificial" anode rods, because they prevent corrosion by an electrochemical reaction with impurities in your water, which causes the anode rods to waste away gradually. They sacrifice themselves so your tank may live. Once a water heater tank rusts through, there is no possibility of repair, only replacement.

Anode rods typically last around 3-5 years, but that can vary quite a bit depending on your water quality, usage, water temperature, and the quality of your water heater's metal parts. Water softeners may speed up the process. Anodes can corrode in as little as six months if the water is over-softened.

When there's no sacrificial metal left on the rod, the tank will quickly rust out. Sometimes a depleted anode rod will break off and fall to the bottom of the water heater tank, where it will cause rapid deterioration of the tank lining and radically shorten the life of your water heater.

If your faucet aerators start clogging up more frequently, that may be a sign of a deteriorated anode rod. You may notice a slimy gel-like substance when cleaning a faucet aerator. Another signal could be a "rotten egg" odour emanating from your hot water.

The odour is caused by anode rods reacting with otherwise harmless bacteria that feed off of hydrogen gas produced by magnesium anode rods. One way of solving the problem is to switch to aluminum/zinc/tin rods and change them more frequently. It's less expensive to replace anode rods than an entire water heater.

The only sure way to tell if an anode rod is near the end of its useful life is to remove the tank top and make a visual inspection. Most people don't know how or don't want to do this. It's one of the most important services provided by our technicians. Our technicians can also flush out your water heater to remove harmful sediment that builds up inside your water heater leading to decreased efficiency and deterioration.

A given repair might only require replacing a little part.


But the value of our skilled technician comes from knowing which part to replace.
